

In Barcelona on the 28th of October, houses and social centers were raided and nine people were arrested in the course of a new anti-terrorist operation orchestrated by the Catalan police and the Spanish State. On the 4th of November, five more are arrested, this time in Madrid. These are the latest in a series of repressive strikes in the country since December of last year. The government's invention of a fictional terrorist group—the GAC-FAI-IRF—is used to justify their imprisonment. While no attacks have ever been claimed with the acronym, the GAC (Coordinated Anarchist Groups) do claim to have authored a recent book *Contra la Democracia*. Copies of this book have been seized by the authorities as evidence in their case, demonstrating the clearly political nature of the arrests.

These police operations come at a critical time when new terrains of struggle have emerged, both in Spain and globally. While the progressive *Podemos* party attempts to monopolize resistance movements, the State lashes out at those who fight relentlessly for self-determination. We see a distinct connection with the United States: both the Democratic Party, as well as various NGOs, seek to manage struggle, those who refuse are met with police batons and tear gas.

We find it vital in the struggle against oppression to show unwavering solidarity with those arrested in Spain.
